Introduction

As requested, I have collected and analyzed information on quantity of museum and galleries visitors. My findings are presented below.

Generalization

The main point in the collected data for almost all museums and galleries is that the quantity of visitors has significantly increased. On the other hand, museums which began collecting admission fee are now experiencing attendance loss.

Comparison

British Museum, National and Tate galleries now have much more visitors than they had in 2013. Amongst them, British Museum experiences greatest increase of attendance, 3.6 mln and 5.1 mln in 2013 and 2015 respectively, which proved it to be appealing. The least visited gallery in 2013, Tate Gallery, now is one of the most visited museums, compared to previous years. Natural History and Science museums, which were most visited museums in England in 2013 with substantial 3.7 and 3.8 mln, after introduction of admission charges in 2014 experienced drastic loss of audience in 2015.

Recommendations

First of all, Natural History and Science museums must stop taking charges to stay popular. Governmental fees are already drawing on people's money, and most of them just cannot afford paid museums. At this rate, there is a chance that these museums will close. On the contrary, British Museum, National and Tate galleries must introduce more exhibitions in order to hold their marks.
