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Visits to English Museums and Galleries Survey Report

As requested, I have analysed the statistics about the amount of visits to English museums and galleries in 2013, 2015, 2017.

The popularity of some museums and galleries increased. For instance, in 2013 there were 2.6 million visitors in British Museum. But in 2015 this amount almost doubled and was about 5.1 million. Moreover, we can see ^{the} same situations in National Gallery, where visiting rate rose on 1.6 million, and Tate Gallery, in which the amount in 2015 was on 1 million bigger than in 2013.

Unsurprisingly, in 2017 in these places there was no change in dynamics, drawing on the data. Although the amount of visits accelerated not so enormously, as between 2013 and 2015, at least it was bigger. It shows that the development of these places moves in a right way.

On the other hand, in National History and Science museums loss in visits is gigantic. However, it is reasonable because in 2014 these museums introduced admission charges.

In 2015 the visitors amount in National History museum was less than a half of 2013 number and in Science museum - less than ^{one} a third.

To sum up, you can see the main reason of increasing or decreasing of popularity. In free places popularity grew respectively. As for museums with substantial fees, their popularity fell. So we can realise that one of the biggest reasons of reaching the popularity peak is free ticket system. As well, the collections of museums and galleries should become larger in order to make more people interested in it. I hope that my recommendations will be useful.
